

Highway 56 Bridge Replacement

Over North Fork Zumbro River in Kenyon and Over Prairie Creek near Stanton

Project Overview

The Minnesota Department of Transportation will be replacing two bridges on Highway 56 in 2017; one bridge over the North Fork Zumbro River in Kenyon (Location 1) and one bridge over Prairie Creek near Stanton (Location 2). The Kenyon bridge will be constructed in stages (half at a time), while the Stanton bridge will be removed and replaced.

Traffic Management

Kenyon (Location 1) - Hwy 56 at the bridge in Kenyon is expected to remain open for the majority of the construction, managed by temporary signals. One short-term closure to vehicles over 5-ton will be necessary to complete the bridge connection.

Stanton (Location 2) – Hwy 56 will be closed and detoured for construction of the bridge near Stanton.

- The proposed detour route includes rerouting Hwy 56 traffic onto Hwy 19, Hwy 52, and Goodhue County Road 9.

Project Schedule

- Letting: February 24, 2017
- Construction start: May 1, 2017
- Estimated construction end: Mid-October 2017
 - Bridge Location 2: Mid-August 2017
 - Bridge Location 1: Mid-October 2017

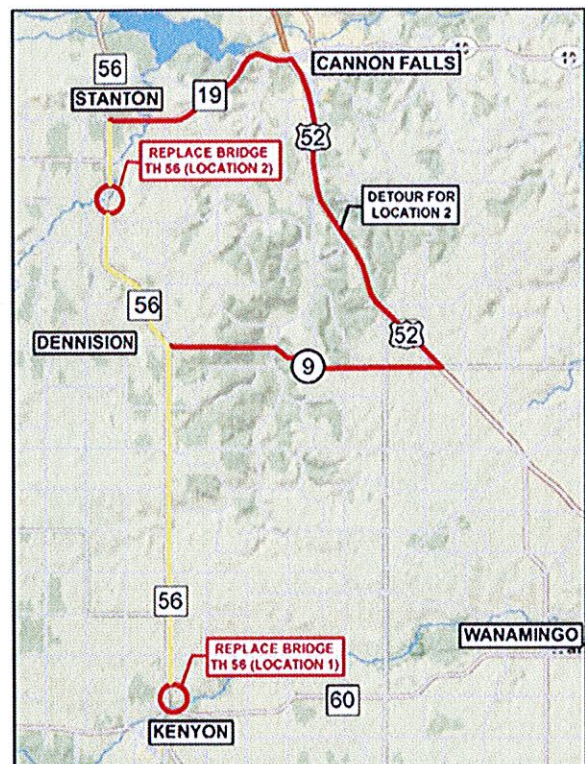
