Kenyon's 38th Annual Carriage and Cutter Day will be held on Saturday, February 25, 2017. You are invited to come and join us! Complete and return the entry form below.

LOCATION: Kenyon, MN, about 50 miles south of Mpls./St. Paul at the intersection of US Hwy 56 and 60.

PLACE: The Staging and Registration area is the Foldcraft Co. parking lot, (615 Centennial Dr.) located on Hwy. 56 South.

Dinner is at the Kenyon Fire Department, which is located on Main Street, on the east side of town, next to the BP Gas Station and across from Kenyon City Hall. A shuttle bus will be provided for participant and spectator convenience.

TIME: Unloading starts at 9:30 a.m. Mounted riders will assist you in finding a place to park.
Registration is from 10:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.
Dinner will be served from 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
The parade will leave the staging area at 1:15, and start on Main St. at 1:30.

DINNER: There will be a free hog roast dinner for all parade participants, provided by the City of Kenyon and the Goodhue County Pork Producers Association.

****Early entry is very much encouraged. In order to speed the entry process, all unit numbers will be assigned, and the parade order will be done prior to parade day. Your registration materials will be ready to pick up when you sign in. (Parade day entries will be taken until 12:30 on parade day.)
